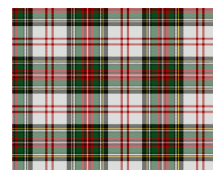

FIBER ARTS DEMONSTRATORS NEEDED

Several times each year COSW has the opportunity to share the world of fiber arts with the public. We're developing a list of members who are willing to be contacted to see if you are available when we have demonstrator openings needing to be filled. Being on the list does not obligate you to any specific event. Having the list will help us know what events and activities we may be able to commit to as a group, especially when timelines are short.

If you are willing to demonstrate your knowledge please contact *Sandy Prock* to get on the list. Let her know your contact information, if you can demonstrate spinning or weaving or some other type of fiber art (knitting, crocheting, needle felting, tablet weaving, kumihimo, etc.), and if you can bring your own equipment or if you would need to make use of COSW equipment (primarily table looms). If you have a more formal type of presentation suitable for a group setting (rather than demonstrating to people who stroll by and ask questions) let her know that as well.

Tartan Workshop / Ready, Set Weave !

COSW Guild member Linda Davis has offered to provide a tartan weaving workshop in mid March, 2018. In this workshop, each student will select their own tartan and type of project they wish to weave (scarf, runner or towel). Linda will provide each student with their threadcount for the chosen tartan and identify the colors and types of fibers needed. Each student will work on their own loom and tartan (4 shaft looms required). Two months advanced preparation is needed for this workshop.

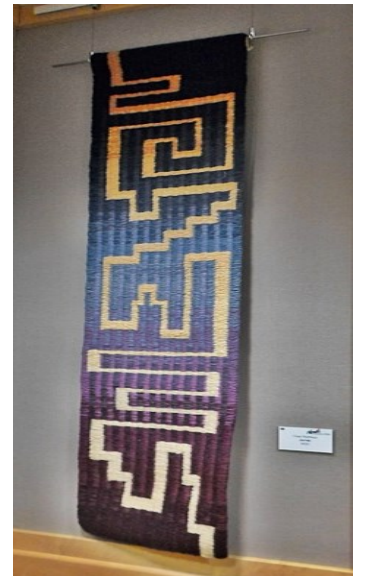


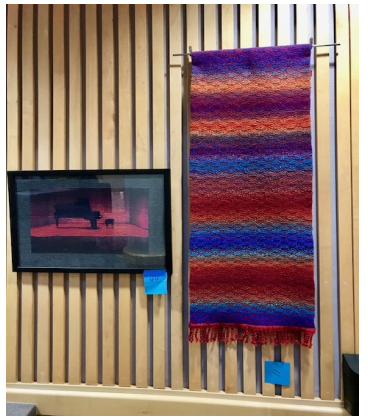

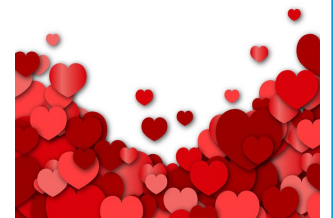
